- 3. Matters arising from 2022 minutes womens club captain to be addressed
- 4. The Chairman, Tarni Dixon delivered his statement (attached) with a review of the year including junior, women, girls and senior sections of the club and reported that more cricket was played on the green during 2023 than in any other season.
